



Notes de dégustation La Fleur de Boüard Millésime 2017

JEB DUNNUCK

91-93/100

I continue to love this cuvée from the team of Hubert de Boüard, and the 2017 La Fleur de Boüard is another rocking good wine that does everything right. Deep inky-colored with serious amounts of red and black fruits, leafy herbs and spring flowers, it hits the palate with a rounded, supple, beautifully textured profile that's already hard to resist. It has sweet tannin and will probably benefit from short-term cellaring, but it's going to offer pleasure right out of the gate as well.

JAMES SUCKLING

91-92/100

This is very soft and attractive in nature with a medium body, pretty fruit and a firm tannin undertone. Hints of chocolate throughout.

JEAN-MARC QUARIN

92/100

Couleur rouge, sombre intense. Nez intense, fruité, de type mûr, avec une touche originale d'aiguille de pin. Vin suave et distingué qui glisse en bouche avec de l'éclat dans le goût. Il s'achève séveux, long, sur un corps droit, mais charnu. Finale délicieuse et incrachable. Assemblage 95 % de merlot et 5 % de cabernet sauvignon. Rendement très faible de 24 hectolitres sur 40 hectares !

YVES BECK

92/100

Rouge grenat dense aux reflets violacés. Bouquet fruité, rafraîchissant aux notes de baies rouges et d'épices. Attaque friande. Au palais, le vin a du jus, une touche gourmande et des tannins aux grains fins. Ces derniers donnent une bonne dimension au vin et assurent les arrières. Seule la finale est quelque peu asséchante mais parallèlement elle présente une belle intensité fruitée. 2023-2032

VERT DE VIN

92-93/100

The nose is fruity, fresh, gourmand and offers unctuousness. It reveals notes of crushed blackberry, crushed strawberry and small notes of crushed red berries combined with touches of liquorice, ripe berries, chocolate, sweet spices as well as very slight touches of cardamom, gray pepper and an imperceptible hint of flowers in the background. The palate is fresh, fruity, well-balanced and offers a beautiful acid frame, tension, a racy minerality as well as finesse. On the palate this wine expresses notes of fresh raspberry, juicy red berries associated with small touches of blackberry, discreet touches of fresh flowers as well as slight touches of cardamom, slight toasted touches, a very slight touch of crushed almond (in the background) and a very discreet hint of gray pepper (in the background). Tannins are fine and very slightly firm. Good length. There is a touch of vanilla on the persistence.

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
