WINE ENTHUSIAST :

93/100

JEFF LEVE :

95-96/100

JEAN MARC QUARIN :

95/100

Couleur sombre, intense et profonde. Nez intense, fruité et truffé. Moelleux et fondant dès l'attaque, puis juteux et très parfumé en milieu de bouche, caressant, mais aussi gras. Le vin avance sur une très belle texture, à la tannicité enveloppée et une grande finale sèveuse. C'est très bon.

JAMES SUCKLING :

95/100

This is a big and dense red with plenty of fruit and powerful tannins. Full body, a solid core of fruit and ripe tannins and a long and flavorful finish. Like a traditionally styled red from a great vintage decades ago, but it's today's rendition. Try in 2022.

JEB DUNNUCK :

96/100

Even more impressive, the 100% Merlot 2015 La Fleur De Bouard Le Plus is a vineyard/parcel selection from clay and limestone soils that was brought up all in new oak. This sensational, full-bodied, viscous 2015 boasts a deep purple color, awesome notes of cassis and black currant fruits, lots of truffle, smoke herbs and meatiness, sweet tannin, and most of its oak covered by a wealth of fruit. It's a gorgeous wine and I suspect one of the best efforts out there from this appellation. Drink it anytime over the coming two decades.

JANCIS ROBINSON :

16,5/20

VERT DE VIN :

95/100

The nose is fine, elegant, generous and aromatic. It reveals notes of coffee and fine notes of blackberry, fresh cassis associated with touches of violet as well as discreet woody notes and small touches of almond. The palate is fruity, mineral, elegant, well-balanced and offers a beautiful definition / precision, a nice structure, a beautiful harmony as well as a beautiful, silky, sleek and slightly untuous matter. In the mouth this wine expresses notes of blackberry, plum and slight notes of cassis associated with touches of fresh red berries, coffee, oak, violets as well as a hint of liquorice and fine notes of chocolate. Good length and persistence. A beautiful and harmonious wine!

RENE GABRIEL :

Extrem dunkles Purpur mit lila und violetten Reflexen. Die Nase ist eine volle Cassisbombe, aber nicht nur, es sind auch feine Edelholznoten und nussige Konturen mit dabei. Im Gaumen füllig, die Textur ist massiv konzentriert, die Tannine zeigen aber Rundungen und die Säure weiss diesen Kraftakt zu stützen. Er wird die relativ lange Ausbaudauer – dank seinem Potential - wohl gut überstehen.
