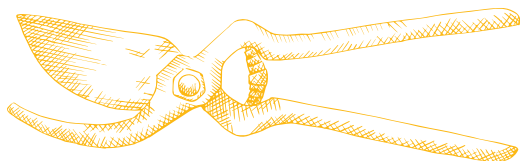

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Chardonnay

- PGI : Vin de Pays de l'Atlantique
- Vineyard area : 3.45 hectares (8.53 acres)
- Soil type : Clayey limestone, Sandy clay over
ferruginous sandstone
- Planting density : 8,500 vines per hectare
- Cultivation : Gironde method
- Soil management : Grass cover crop + tillage
- Grape variety : 100% Chardonnay
- Yield : 50 hectolitres per hectare (first harvest)
- Harvest : The fruit is sorted in the vineyard
and transported in crates
- Winemaking techniques : The fruit is immediately pressed and
protected by an inert gas, allowed to settle
for 48 hours, then stabilised cold
- Soak after fermentation : 15 days, then malolactic fermentation at less
than 18°C (64°F) in barrels
- Barrel-ageing : In 400-litre casks made of French oak
- Annual production : 15,000 bottles



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
