Attracted to business studies, he pursued a DUT in International Business. Eager to maintain a connection to the wine industry, he completed an internship in a vinevard in the Colchagua Valley. Building on this experience, he continued with a Bachelor's degree in International Business in Wines and Spirits at the University of Reims and the Viticultural High School of Champagne. He furthered his internships in vineyards both in France (Burgundy at Domaine G&Y Dufouleur in Nuits-Saint-Georges) and abroad (Bodega | Miguel Jané Vilafranca del Penedès).

In 2010, he decided to redirect his focus to production and embarked on a vocational training program, pursuing a BTS in Viticulture and Oenology through an apprenticeship at Château Angelus. His journey and education unfolded alongside Hubert de Boüard and his team, enriching him with the viticultural and oenological practices of a premier Grand Cru Classé. Graduating in 2012, Hubert de Boüard entrusted him with the winemaking responsibilities at Château de Francs in Côtes de Bordeaux. Convinced that he had found his path, he pursued the National Diploma of Oenology, which he obtained in June 2015.

In the same year, he joined Hubert de Boüard Consulting. Then, in 2023, he assumed the role of Technical Director in the new team at Château La Fleur de Boüard.



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
